BUZZETTI, GENERAL MANAGER CSC COSTRUZIONI: 'PRELIMINARY WORK ON NEW RAILWAY INDUSTRIAL PLANT KICKS OFF IN TICINO, SWITZERLAND'

HIGHLY DIGITIZED PLANT THAT WILL RUN ONLY ON RENEWABLE ENERGY

Lugano, 19 November 2024 – Preliminary work has begun on the construction of the New Railway Industrial Facility (NSIF) in Arbedo-Castione, in the canton of Ticino in Switzerland, worth about €310 million. With a 67 percent share, CSC Costruzioni (Webuild Group) leads the Consorzio Officine Ticinesi (OFT), with Sottas, which last May won the project commissioned by the Swiss Federal Railways (SBB). The new facility, intended for the maintenance of electric trains and locomotives, will be highly digitized and run only on renewable energy. The contract includes the execution of preparatory activities for the start of construction and the construction of the main building, attached technical buildings and outdoor spaces.

Matteo BUZZETTI, General Manager CSC Costruzioni said, “This important success highlights CSC Construction's expertise and commitment to the civil engineering and general contractor sectors and reinforces our position as a Swiss leader in highly complex multidisciplinary projects. We are proud to be able to contribute, with our group and partners, to the realization of this major project, which will support the economic growth of the Canton of Ticino.”

CSC Costruzioni has been working in Switzerland for more than 60 years, designing and building sustainable structures. With more than 20 projects underway in the country, the company is currently engaged in the implementation of high-tech and innovative projects, such as the extension of a Data Centre in Gland, near Geneva, one of the largest data processing centers in the country, and the renovation of the historic buildings of the Palais des Nations, also in Geneva, a complex project that aims to ensure security and sustainability for the historic offices of the United Nations in the city, without disrupting its operations.

Among the projects successfully completed by CSC Costruzioni are the Parc du Simplon Project, including the SBB headquarters urban redevelopment and green building initiative that created a new neighborhood, with commercial and residential buildings with “Minergie P” certification, 5 kilometers from the center of Lausanne ; the Hospice Les Maraîchers project, an ambitious initiative that has made available 108 apartments, plus additional office space, built according to advanced sustainability criteria and certified “Minergie P-ECO” in the heart of the city of Geneva; and the Rive Droite Project with two green buildings of 77 housing units in the heart of Switzerland with “SEED” certification.
